Chartered:

Homewood-Flossmoor Park District was established by a merger of the Homewood Park District and the Flossmoor Park District in January 1969.

Governance:

Homewood-Flossmoor Park District's governing board consists of an elected board of five commissioners. Commissioners are elected to serve a six-year term, serving without compensation.

Officers:

Commissioners elect from among themselves a president and a vice president. An outside treasurer is appointed annually. The secretary of the board is also appointed annually. The president, vice president, treasurer and secretary serve one-year terms.

Appointed Officials:

The commissioners appoint a director and an attorney. The director serves as chief executive officer of the park district and carries out the policies of the board.

Boundaries:

Homewood-Flossmoor Park District serves two communities—Homewood and Flossmoor. The district is nearly conterminous to each village's boundaries and extends into a small portion of Glenwood to the east.

H-F Park District's approximate boundaries are 175th Street on the north, Halsted Avenue on the east, Vollmer Road on the south and Pulaski Avenue on the west.

Population:

The population served by H-F Park District numbers approximately 30,000 residents.

Real Estate:

The equalized assessed valuation of real estate for 2007 is \$667,649,323.

Tax Rate:

The tax rate for 2007 was .775.

Fiscal Year Budget:

H-F Park District's operating budget for the fiscal year 2009-10 is \$14,435,387. The fiscal year begins on May 1 and concludes on April 30.

Parks & Facilities:

Homewood-Flossmoor Park District owns 32 park sites and controls more than 365 acres of land.

Its parks include a skateboard park, 25 outdoor tennis courts, 12 soccer fields and 12 ballfield diamonds. Park District facilities include H-F Racquet & Fitness Club, Coyote Run Golf Course, H-F Ice Arena, Marie Irwin Community Center, Goldberg Administration Center, H-F Park District Auditorium, Irons Oaks Environmental Learning Center, Lions Club Pool and Dolphin Lake Pool. *(For a more complete listing of facilities and parks, please turn to the reverse side.)*

Staffing:

The Park District has a full-time staff of more than 54 employees. The district also employs more than 700 part-time, seasonal and temporary workers.

Affiliations:

Homewood-Flossmoor Park District is affiliated with the National Recreation and Park Association, the Illinois Association of Park Districts and the Illinois Park and Recreation Association.
