FAQs

Where will the Dog Jog take place?

The Dog Jog start and finish line is located in Apollo park, near the pavilion.

Where should I park when I come to the event?

Event parking is located off of May Street near the intersection of Morgan Street and Bowling Green. Limited spaces are available in the parking lot at the end of 191st Street.

What if I don't have a dog? Can I still participate?

Absolutely! This race is for everyone and you can participate whether you have a dog or not.

Do I need to be a member of Rover's Run to participate?

This race is open to everyone, so you do not need to be a member of Rover's Run. But, you should check out our Rover's Run membership – it's a great perk.

Does my dog need to stay on-leash the entire time?

Yes, for the safety of everyone, including the dogs, please keep your dog on-leash throughout the event.

How old does the owner need to be to participate?

Participants need to be at least 12 years of age.

Are there age categories and prizes for winners?

At this time, we will give out prizes to the first place male and first place female.

What if it is raining, snowing, sleeting, or other inclement weather?

We are hoping for the best weather, but we are focused on the safety of everyone involved. We will shut down the race if it is icy or lightning or there are dangerous conditions. If it is snowy or rainy or cold, we will still run the race.
