Hours: 8 a.m.-Dusk SAFETY RULES & GUIDELINES

Extreme Scene Skate Park is unsupervised and participants skate at their own risk.

In-line skating and skateboarding are high-risk recreation activities with inherent risks of serious injury. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, children ages 5 and younger should not use skateboards.

Skaters are responsible for inspecting equipment prior to use to ensure it is safe for skating. Do not use park equipment if it is broken or wet. Call the Park District at 708-957-0300 if equipment is damaged. Do not use the skate park during electrical storms or inclement weather.

- Only skateboards and in-line skates are permitted in this park. Bicycles are not allowed. Persons not skating are prohibited from using the skating structures.
- Skaters must wear protective helmets, elbow pads, knee pads, shoes, etc.
- Personally-owned ramps, boxes and other devices shall not be brought in this park.
- Food and drink are not allowed inside the fenced skating area.
- Smoking and alcohol are prohibited.
- Profanity, reckless behavior, pushing, bullying, etc. are not allowed.
- Tagging, graffiti and stickers are not allowed—except on the designated “graffiti board” (must not contain vulgar/offensive material or gang-related symbols).
- For safety reasons, skaters shall not wear headphones. Boom boxes are allowed, as long as the music is appropriate and does not contain profanity or offensive lyrics. Volume should be kept to a minimum, as to not disturb other park patrons and park neighbors.

In the event skate park rules are not being followed, H-F Park District may elect to temporarily or permanently close this park.
